2012-2013 INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORGANIZATION APPLICATIONS

Please read these instructions carefully.

The Louis C. McConaughy Fund makes grants available to organizations dedicated to educational and other charitable causes. However, the primary purpose of the McConaughy grant program is to provide grants to individuals pursuing higher education. Therefore, applications from organizations will be considered based on the availability of funds after applications from individuals have been reviewed.

Applications from organizations whose primary mission is educational in nature are generally given priority over applications from organizations whose primary mission is not educational; applications from organizations whose primary mission is not educational will be considered based on the availability of funds once applications from individuals and educational organizations have been reviewed.

The Trustees of the Fund are most interested in helping support educational initiatives that directly impact students; applications for grants intended to cover administrative or other operating expenses, or to provide funding for other grant programs, are generally not given as much consideration as are applications for grants intended to support student development or that otherwise can be shown to have some direct outcome in the furtherance of the mission of the organization.

Organizations wishing to submit an application are asked to observe the following:

- make sure you're using the current version of the application form (applications using previous versions will not be considered);
- along with a completed application, please submit a detailed budget explaining how you anticipate using any grant you receive from the McConaughy Fund;
- all application materials must be received by Trinity Episcopal Church no later than Tuesday, 1 May 2012; applications postmarked on this date will be accepted, but late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Responses to all applications will be mailed by Friday, 29 June 2012. The Trustees of the McConaughy Fund reserve the right to publicize information regarding grants awarded by the Fund, including the names of grant recipients and the amount of any grant they receive from the Fund.
